The latest ray from Green Wolf Lighting is a collaboration with jewellery designer Solange Azagury Partridge

These pieces constitute a remarkable fusion between traditional craftmanship and modern design, echoing the meticulous precision inherent in Solange's jewellery.

Using the unique functionality introduced by Green Wolf Lighting's first collection of sustainable, rechargable, cordless Murano glass lights, this collaboration is infused for the first time with Solange's iconic designs found across her jewellery collections.

Solange has created five designs for this collection that evoke some of her characteristic motifs. Reflecting her unwavering love for vibrant colour palettes and symbolically charged elements such as the sun and the rainbow, these lights serve as an artistic extension of her renowned jewellery.



Cloud

Paying attention to the rhythms of nature, Solange evokes the elemental forces that shape our environment.

The Cloud light invites viewers to reflect upon the mutable character of the seasons, and in turn, how the natural world impacts our human sensibilities. Crafted from blue glass with an ethereal pink cloud suspended in the central compartment, the Cloud light stands as a poignant reminder that even amid life's transitory states, there exists the promise of a silver lining.



Sun

Formed of acid yellow glass, the Sun light features a glass ball of orange flames burning at the core of the piece.

This presentation invokes the dualistic nature of the sun both as a life-giving energy and a beacon of hope but also as a volatile and destructive star that has the potential to destroy worlds.

In this dichotomy, this Sun light serves as a poignant reminder of the delicate equilibrium that exists within our universe, underscoring the importance of balance in nature.



Rainbow

The Rainbow light is a fascinating blend of symbolism, drawing from nature, biblical narratives and social situations, all revolving around the enchantment of the rainbow.

What make this natural wonder so enthralling is its humble origin – a mere refraction of light through raindrops, resulting in the full spectrum of colours we admire. The rainbow is a symbol that recurrently permeates Solange's oeuvre, continuously fascinating and inspiring her.

Seven hand blown arches of the rainbow sit inside a Rubino pink shade, a colour exclusive to Murano.



Home


Within this light, there emerges a miniature cottage that embodies the ideals of solidity and safety. This piece serves as a fundamental testament to one of the most basic human rights: a place to call home. Engulfed in grey tinted glass, the house boasts a charming red roof, and is adorned with windows painted in blue and yellow, along with a balcony at the back of the house from which to admire the sunset. These vibrant primary hues evoke a sense of simplicity that resonates deeply with the notions of home, representing the core essentials that every human being aspires to.



Eden

The Garden of Eden light captures a scene of prelapsarian perfection, an Edenic sanctuary of abundance and lush beauty. Crafted from hand blown green glass, the scene centres around the Tree of Life, a symbol of eternal vitality and spiritual purity.

At the very roots of the tree, a sinuous orange serpent is elegantly captured in glass, forever immortalising the moment of perfection, just before Eve is tempted by the apple. This light preserves the serene and unspoiled harmony of Eden, a place when life flourished, undisturbed by original sin and human fallibility.
